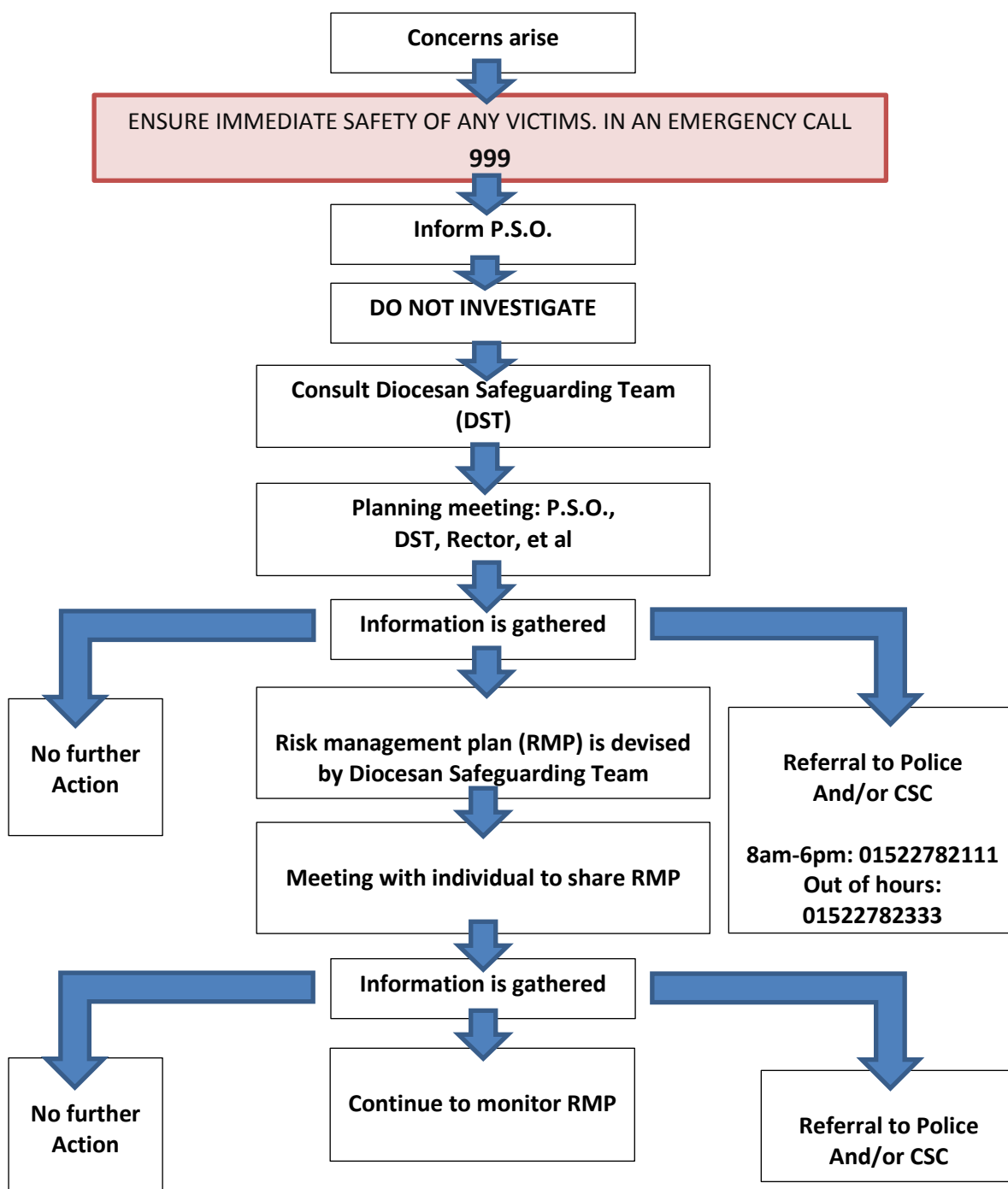




PROCEDURE WHEN CONCERNS ARISE ABOUT AN ADULT POSING A RISK



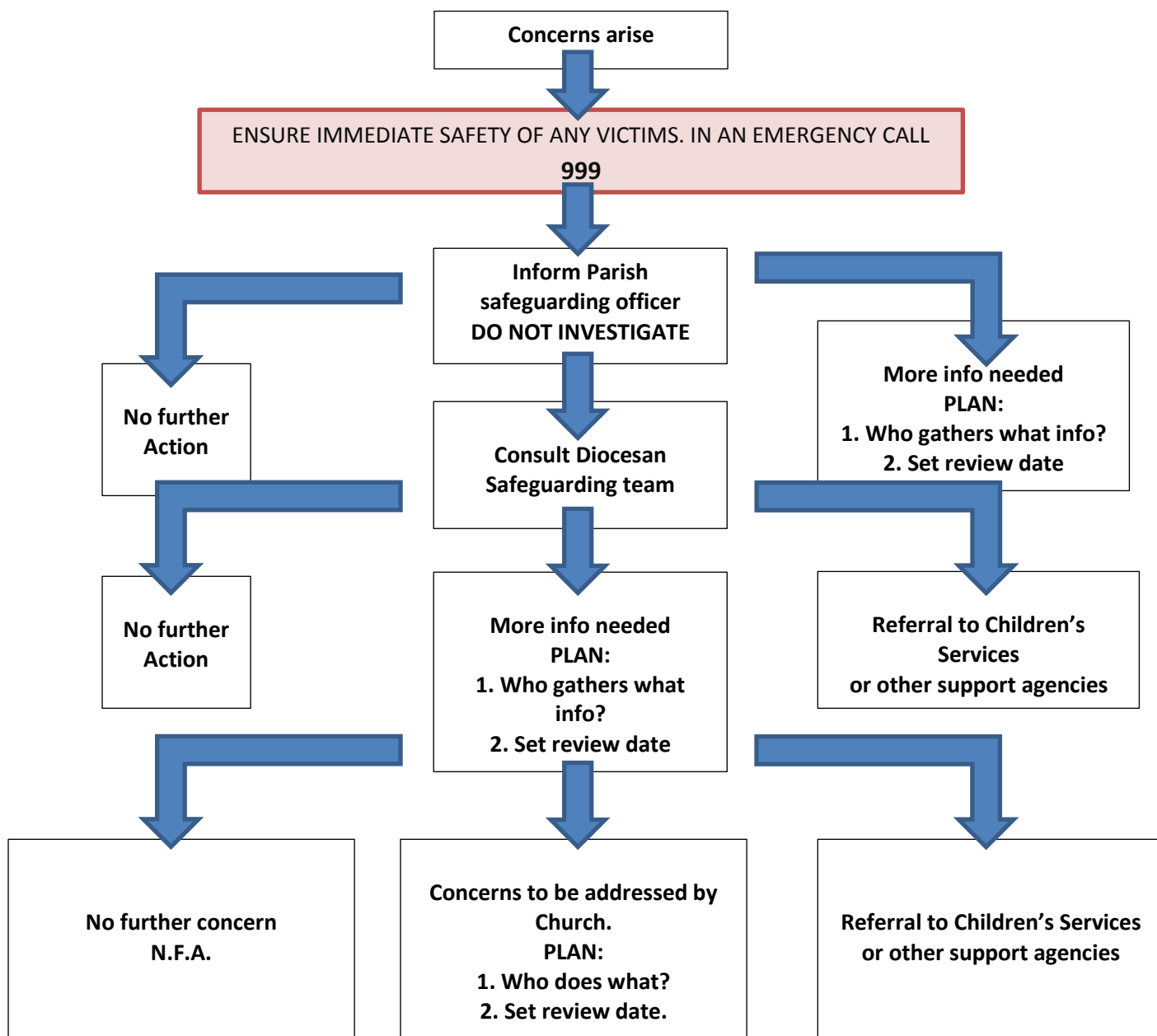

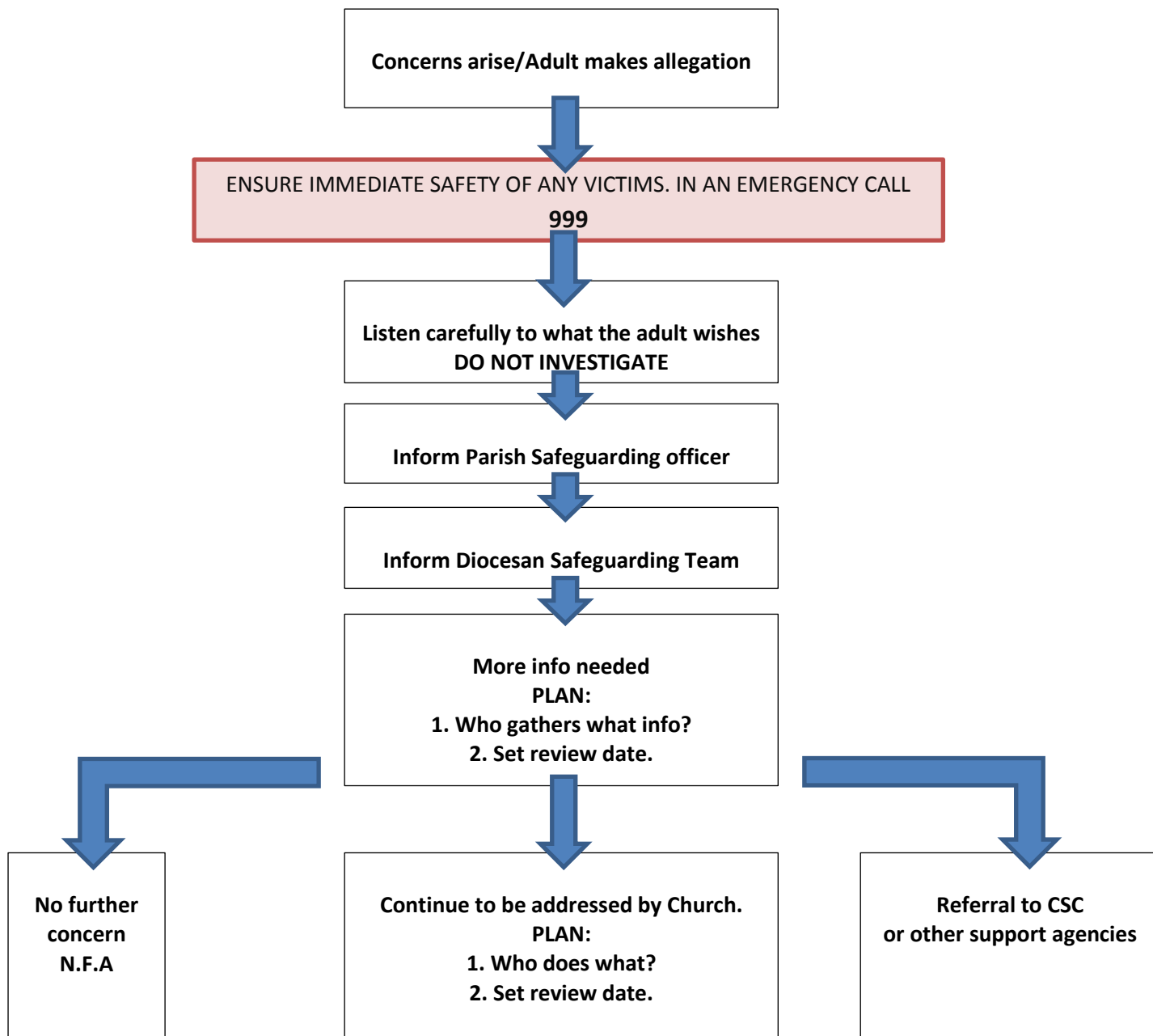
