Role title	Church Flower Arranger
Purpose	To provide floral arrangements in church either as part of the annual rota or to join with a larger team for specific celebratory events.
Tasks and responsibilities	<p>For flower arrangers on the routine rota we ask that they prepare either a pedestal type arrangement near the pulpit or a low arrangement under the altar. The rota is scheduled for every 2 weeks so the arrangement needs to be prepared and then checked upon and watered for the set period of time.</p> <p>Church can provide the basic “mechanics” – pedestals, bowls, oasis, wire etc, but arrangers provide their own flowers and foliage of choice.</p> <p>For arrangers joining for larger team events flowers and foliage are also provided – although additional flowers, foliage and other additions are always welcome.</p>
Skills, experience and attributes needed	Experience welcomed but not required – just a love of flowers and willing to have a go.

Support offered	As above some materials are provided and help, support and guidance is readily available.
